revision 6, TCCA approved February 1, 2017, or later TCCA approved revisions. 3. Aircraft must be maintained in accordance with Airbus Helicopters Canada Limited Instructions for Continued Airworthiness ICA-AHCA-279, revision 0, TCCA accepted December 8, 2014, or later TCCA accepted revisions.

1. The installer must determine whether this design change is compatible with previously approved modifications.
