

We're looking for a Composite Sanding Technician Position Location: Fort Erie, ON

Reporting to the Paint Supervisor, the Composite Sanding and Paint Technician prepares, masks and applies paint to composite or metallic components in accordance to process specification

MAIN RESPONSIBILITIES

Preparation

- Wash composite panel with alcohol or recommended solvent
- Ensure all composite panels are investigated thoroughly for defects

Sanding Composite Panels

- Sand and fill composite panel before priming
- Fill all pin holes found in composite panel before re-priming

Removing Surface Dust

- Use compressed air to blow away and remove dust and contaminants from composite panel
- Clean composite panel with the recommended and appropriate solvent to completely remove remainder of dust

Apply Primer

- Masking of the unpainted areas using paper masking or masking tape
- Apply multiple stages / types of primer to composite panels
- Ensure panels receive proper bake / cure cycles

Inspection

- Inspect completed composite panels
- Removal of masking
- Checking the paint thickness
- Buffing, Touch-ups and other finesse work





EDUCATION & JOB REQUIREMENTS

- · Completion of high school is required or equivalent
- Previous sanding + prepping experience would be an asset
- Able to use various hand tools such as sanders, sanding blocks, etc.
- Must be able to work in a team environment as well as independently
- Attention to detail
- Self-starter and able to work under minimal supervision
- Able to use judgement in order to solve common problems
- Must be able to work shift work

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS

Job responsibilities and tasks are all performed indoors. The incumbent in this position may be exposed to industrial chemicals, corrosives, isocyanates, dusts and irritants. Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) must be worn.

Other hazards include high levels of noise, slippery surfaces, and sharp objects such as knives and blades.

The incumbent in this role may be required to work excessive overtime during certain times of the year in addition to a regular scheduled work week.
