The incumbent ensures alignment between IM and the AHCA Business priorities through regular communication and collaboration with the IM team and AHCA Management and routinely organizes project and service reviews with the AHCA Business functions. The incumbent will be responsible to coordinate, manage & execute project delivery and support solutions in accordance with the Airbus IM operating Model. The IM Site Relationship Manager (SRM) and Industrial Solutions Manager monitors the IM services performance execution at AHCA and promotes and deploys state of the art digital solutions in the Industrial Solutions perimeter in line with AIRBUS Operating Model and Standards.

IM Site Relationship Management

- Manage IM top incidents, problems and their mitigation plans, etc.
- Follow usage and performance of IM products and/or services in the plant
- Participate in the operational and management routings needed in the plant
- Represents IM and promotes its vision, values, services, and capabilities
- Acts as an advocate on behalf of business stakeholders to ensure IM services & products meet his/her business priorities and needs
- Accountable for guaranteeing the proper level of service according to agreed SLA established with the business functions
- Serve as first point of escalation for all IT related customer issues
- Define and revise Service Level Requirements with local Business stakeholders

Projects

- Support Manufacturing / Operations activities and manage the associated demand
- Compile the Plant Demand Priorities for IM PSLs to provide a local and consistent view of the IM products and/or services being used and their roadmap
- Collect and Coordinate local Business needs and address to the relevant PSL
- Responsible for the roll-out of Group IM-supported processes, programs, information systems for Industrial Solutions Product/Service





- Drive continuous improvement of all products and services within the Industrial Solutions Product/Service, in all
 aspects (financial, user experience, efficiency, effectiveness, simplification, technical performance, cyber
 security, resilience, obsolescence etc.) and across the full application lifecycle (design, build, run)
- Maintain a backlog of work with clear priorities agreed with the respective business stakeholders
- Overall accountability on the performance (delivery, costs, people management and well-being) of the related product teams. Product scope is end-to-end (Design / Build / Run)
- Enables an optimum relay between the strategic decisions and commitments taken at IM Leadership Team and Business counterpart(s) along with the execution of these decisions and commitments at product level teams, the heart of IM value creation and delivery
