- Support the Head of IM Infrastructure & Operations in managing the local staff in charge of infrastructure projects and services
- Support the Head of IM Industry Solutions and the Head of Infrastructure & Operations by conducting employee performance evaluations and communicating professional development opportunities
- Work with HR to develop people and recommend employee actions including hiring, promotion, transfer and discharge
- Managing the interface among the business, Americas IS/IT teams and central IS/IT teams in Marignane

Projects

- Partner with AHCA business functions to understand business processes and needs in order to propose innovative / digital solutions bringing value to the business
- Benchmark innovative solutions that can bring benefits to AHCA, in line with the overall IM applications standards
- Collaborate with the business on one side and with the infrastructure teams on the other side to ensure
 the proper design and implementation of business application projects in the frame of local, division, or
 group wide initiatives
- Manage and deliver the IM projects on time, on costs and on quality
- Prepare the run mode and ensure a smooth transition to the application services team
- Support the application solutions afterwards according to established SLAs
- Regularly review the performance of the projects and of the services linked

- Liaise and synchronize with the IM infrastructure team to ensure smooth deployment and appropriate level of performance of the end to end services
- Organize and plan deployment activities with the support of the related staff
- Organize the support of the overall IM landscape
- Conduct regular Risk and Opportunity assessments for all AHCA sites to mitigate IS/IT performance impacts

Digital Roadmap

- Partner with AHCA Business Functions to understand business needs in terms of Digitalization and Innovation
- Benchmark Innovation and Digital Initiatives from North America, Airbus Divisions or from the Aerospace Industries
- Support the Digital Roadmap governance to secure the execution of aligned projects
